The Youth Group has a couple of events planned for the Fall, and a couple of others firmly in mind, but yet to be scheduled.

On Friday evening September 21, several youth group members – Alex, Gabby, and Sophia – will be heading down to Trinity Church in Asbury Park with Susanna, Michele, and me for an overnight adventure that involves learning, outreach, and fun. Joining forces with Youth from a number of other parishes around the diocese, we will arrive in the evening, walk the several blocks to the beach, and there learn from Derek Minno-Bloom about their Food Justice program, and then hopefully linger a bit. After sleeping in Trinity's parish hall, we will volunteer in the food pantry from 8 am to 1 pm prepping, preparing, and hosting with a culminating effort making a lunch bag for departing guests. We will enjoy the afternoon on the boardwalk and beach, participate in Trinity's Saturday evening service and reflect upon our work, and then enjoy each other's company at a local restaurant before we return the evening of September 22.

On Saturday October 27 at 9 am we will continue our volunteer efforts at Evergreen Cemetery in Plainfield. All are welcome to join in on this satisfying ongoing service project.

We would like to do a hike one Saturday at Harriman State Park and a walking tour in New York City – like the ones we've done in Lower Manhattan and SoHo/Little Italy/Chinatown – this time in the East Village. Speak with me if you are interested in one of these non-only-Youth-Group events, and keep an eye out for dates.

Later in the Fall we will reestablish a cadence to our Sunday Youth Group meetings over pizza or coffee hour goodies – with a focus on our ever-rewarding Book of Common Prayer.
